Application and Selection Process

Applications are available online at www.hivmedfellowship.com and are accepted from August 1 through October 15 of each application year. The second round of the application process involves onsite interviews between October 15 and November 15. Final cohort selection is completed by November 30. The fellowship program may accept up to four qualified candidates per year and begins on July 1 each year.

Ideal candidates are board-eligible graduates of a residency program in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, or Medicine-Pediatrics with a strong interest in HIV medicine or an interest in building community programs to improve access to quality HIV care.
